

# Self Installation Guide

## 5041 Set Top Box



1. Make sure your TV is turned off. Connect one end of the HDMI cable into your Set Top Box and the other end into your TV.

Note which HDMI input you're using. In this example, we're using HDMI port 2.



2. Turn on your TV and select the correct HDMI source.

3. Connect the power cable to the Set Top Box and wall outlet.



4. Wait for the Set Top Box to start-up then press 'OK' on your remote when the TV displays 'No Network Connection'.



5. Select 'Start WPS' on the top right corner of the screen, then press the 'WPS' button on the router.

If WPS is not available or you cannot find the button, please select your Wi-Fi network on the Wi-Fi setup screen and enter your passcode.



6. Wait for Wi-Fi to connect and your TV is ready to use.

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## TV Remote Programming



Your remote should come programmed but use this guide if it does not turn your TV on/off.

Hold the 'TV' button at the top of the remote and 'OK/SEL' for 3 seconds.

The 'TV' button should light up.

Press channel up or down button repeatedly waiting a moment between presses until your TV turns off.

Press 'TV' again to save configuration.

In order to control both the set top box and your TV please make sure the TV source is selected on the remote by pressing the 'TV' button.

'System ON/OFF' button should turn both your TV and the set top box on/off.
